- February 20 – New Jersey Sales Tax Due
29 – W-2's 1099's due to Social Security Administration
- March 15 – Corporate Tax Returns or Extensions Due
- April 17 – Individual Tax Returns or Extensions Due. Individual Payments due.
1st Quarter Estimated Payments Due

All Individual Tax Returns to be e-filed should be completed by Friday April 13 to ensure timely receipt by IRS and the State.
